

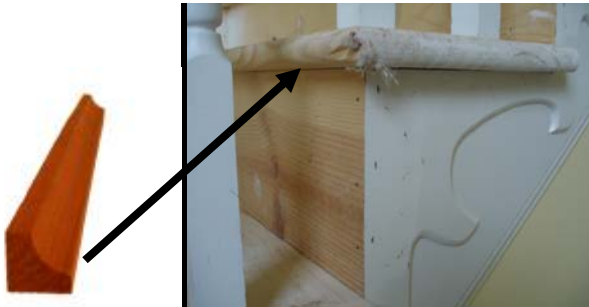
STAIR PARTS 101

Bracket: Brackets are used on the side of an open stair to cover the exposed riser.



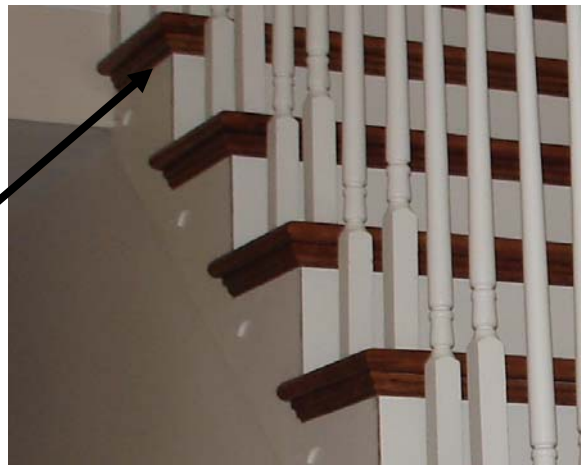
There can be left hand brackets and right hand brackets.

Cove (Scotia) is used under treads and along skirt boards (also know as stringer) 5/8" x 3/4"



Cove is not necessary with EZTREAD. The EZTREAD lips over the riser therefore the cove is not needed.

EZCOVE was design to cover the open end of a mitered tread or under the nose of the tread if desired.



STAIR PARTS 101

Double Mitered Return is a tread that is open on both sides.



Double Starting step is a decorative 1st step often used to accommodate a particular newel post or railing.

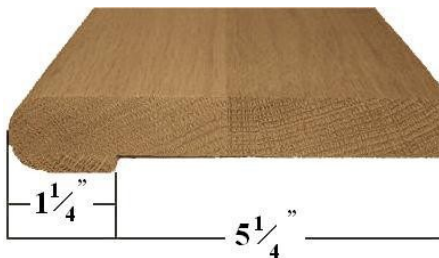


STAIR PARTS 101

Landing Tread: Use Landing tread at the top of the stair or at the landing to meet the floor.
Landing tread is also referred to as stair nose.



Landing Tread can also be used at the bottom of the Balusters. Landing Tread comes in of $3\frac{1}{4}$ " or $5\frac{1}{4}$ " wide (depth).



STAIR PARTS 101

Left hand mitered return. From the bottom of the stair looking up the return is on the left.

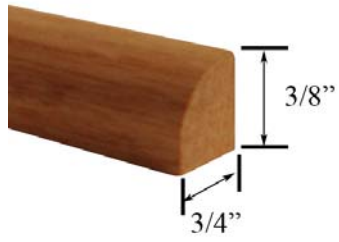


Right Hand Mitered Return is determined by standing at the bottom of the staircase looking up.

Shoe (quarter round) is a stair part that can be used along skirt board or it can be used to trim along



baseboard.
